PBS 45 & 49 Presents Suze Orman: For the Young, Fabulous & Broke

KENT, Ohio — Wednesday, March 2, 2005 — Best-selling author and personal finance expert Suze Orman returns to PBS 45 & 49 with a new special, **Suze Orman: For the Young, Fabulous & Broke**. Airing on March 11 at 10 p.m., the production is aimed at young adults ages 20-40, a generation struggling with unprecedented financial challenges including hefty student loans, credit card debt, a tough job market and skyrocketing housing costs. The show airs again on Saturday, March 12 at 9 a.m. and Sunday, March 13 at 5 p.m.

In the first-ever television program expressly aimed at this age group (and their parents), Orman offers a set of real, not impossible, solutions to the problems at hand and the problems ahead — powerful advice and smart money moves that can help young men and women at what is perhaps the most critical time of their financial lives.—**Suze Orman: For the Young, Fabulous & Broke** is based on Orman's newest book, *The Money Book for the Young, Fabulous & Broke*, to be released concurrently with the television special.

Like all of Orman's work, this program goes well beyond traditional financial analysis. Orman's insights are based upon the real-world interplay of money, values and the human spirit. Taped before an audience at Concordia University in St. Paul, Minn., Orman's show offers surprising and unique advice on managing a career, dealing with the boss, getting a raise, getting married, being a financially responsible parent and feeling powerful about money.

For the most recent of Orman's four previous PBS specials, **The Laws of Money, the Lessons of Life**, she was awarded a 2003 national Emmy for Outstanding Service Show Host. The program was also nominated as Outstanding Service Show.

An internationally acclaimed personal finance expert, Orman has been called a "one-woman financial-advice powerhouse" by USA Today. She is the author of four consecutive New York Times best sellers: The Laws of Money, The Lessons of Life; The Road to Wealth; The Courage to Be Rich; and The 9 Steps to Financial Freedom, and two national best sellers, You've Earned It, Don't Lose It and Suze Orman's Financial Guidebook.
