PBS 45 & 49 to offer gavel-to-gavel coverage of Alito confirmation hearings

KENT, Ohio – Thursday, Jan. 5, 2006 — Starting Monday, Jan. 9 at noon on its digital channels 45-4 and 49-4, PBS 45 & 49 will air **The NewsHour With Jim Lehrer**'s live coverage of hearings on the nomination of Samuel A. Alito, Jr. to be an associate justice of the Supreme Court of the United States. Viewers who have a digital tuner can access the digital programming.

Jim Lehrer, anchor and executive editor of **The NewsHour With Jim Lehrer**, will anchor the special coverage, along with **NewsHour** senior correspondents Gwen Ifill and Ray Suarez. Commentary and analysis will be provided by Mark Shields, syndicated columnist; Ramesh Ponnuru, senior editor of the National Review; and Marcia Coyle, National Law Journal Washington bureau chief. Jan Crawford Greenburg, Supreme Court reporter for *The Chicago Tribune*, will provide live reports from the hearings.
