NORTHEAST OHIO & THE GREAT FLOOD OF 1913

Friday, Nov. 7, at 9 PM

The weather in Northeast Ohio on Easter Sunday in 1913 was supposed to be "generally fair" and cool. The Akron Beacon Journal counseled readers that they could "bring forth your Easter finery." But, as folks left church that Easter morning, a steady, chilly rain started, ruining bonnets, dresses and suits. The rain did not stop.

Over a four-day period, up to a foot of rain fell across Ohio — what came to be known as "the great Ohio flood." The storm remains the worst weather disaster in the history of the state.

Estimates of the number of people killed in the flood vary from around 350 to more than 500, but many historians today believe those numbers are too low. The U. S. Geological Survey put the damage in Ohio at \$143 million, about \$4.5 billion in today's money.

"Just about every city and town in Ohio suffered damages during the storm," said NORTHEAST OHIO & THE GREAT FLOOD OF 1913 producer Fred Endres. "We focus on Akron and Kent in the documentary, and they tend to be fairly representative of what happened in other Northeast Ohio areas."

The program includes dozens of photographs of the flood and flood damage in Akron, Kent and other nearby towns.

Endres said he was amazed at the number and quality of images available through such organizations as the Akron-Summit County Public Library, Kent State University, the University of Akron, the Summit County Historical Society, and the Barberton Public Library.

"Those images really show the extent of the devastation and human suffering in Northeast Ohio and throughout the state," said Endres, thanking local librarians and archivists. "They are unsung heroes."



THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION

THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION examines how America's founding turned the world upside-down. Thirteen British colonies on the Atlantic Coast rose in rebellion, won their independence and established a new form of government that radically reshaped the continent and inspired centuries of democratic movements around the globe.

The much-anticipated series, which has been in production for eight years, was directed and produced by Ken Burns, Sarah Botstein and David Schmidt and written by long-time collaborator Geoffrey C. Ward. The series was produced to commemorate the 250th anniversary of the start of the war, which began in the spring of 1775, more than a year before the Declaration of Independence.

"The American Revolution is one of the most important events in human history," said Ken Burns. "We went from being subjects to inventing a new concept, citizens, and set in motion democratic revolutions around the globe. As we prepare to celebrate the 250th anniversary of our founding, I'm hopeful that people throughout the country will come together to discuss the importance of this history and to appreciate even more what our ancestors did to secure our liberty and freedoms."

The British take Philadelphia, and Congress flees the city. But an American victory at Saratoga allows France to openly support the United States.

Repeats Monday, Nov. 17, at 10:10 PM and Tuesday, Nov. 18, at 1 AM

George Washington takes command of the Continental Army and joins New England's fight to liberate Boston. Congress declares American independence.

The Soul of All America (December 1777-May 1780)

Repeats Thursday, Nov. 20, at 10 PM and Friday, Nov. 21, at 1 AM

After Valley Forge and Monmouth, the war moves to other theaters. Navies battle overseas, while armies advance further into Native land and the South.

The Times That Try Men's Souls (July 1776–January 1777)

Tuesday, Nov. 18, at 8 PM

Repeats Tuesday, Nov. 18, at 10 PM and Wednesday, Nov. 19, at 1 AM

The British overwhelm Washington's army, forcing him to abandon New York City and flee across New Jersey. Americans attack a garrison at Trenton.

EPISODE SIX:

The Most Sacred Thing (May 1780–Onward)

Friday, Nov. 21, at 8 PM

Repeats Friday, Nov. 21, at 10:15 PM and Saturday, Nov. 22, at 1 AM

Supported by the French, Washington wins the decisive victory at Yorktown. In peacetime Americans aspire for a more perfect union.

Dr. Vivek Murthy served as the 19th and 21st Surgeon General of the United States. As Vice Admiral of the U.S. Public Health Service Commissioned Corps, he commanded a uniformed service of 6,000 public health officers.
